

Uniform Protocol

1. To hem jacket sleeves and the green pants; adjust to the correct length and then press. If white pants do not have snaps they may be hemmed by tacking them to the desired length.

Note: no part of the uniform may be cut.

2. When pants are hemmed to the correct leg they should rest on top of the shoe. They should not bunch up.

2. Please do not store uniforms in garment bags. They need to air out after use.

3. Wash white pants and shoes after every competition; jackets as needed.

Students **must** wear white t-shirt or white wick dry tops under jackets and white compression shorts or wick dry thermals under white pants.

5. High, white socks.....skin should not be seen between shoes and pants.

6. When transporting gauntlets they should be kept in a clean plastic bag that is hung from a coat hanger. They should not be near dirty shoes!!

7. Plumes should be kept in tubes.

8. Students are not allowed to eat while in uniform.

Helpful Hints

It is suggested the following items be kept in garment bags:

Hand warmers
Spare socks
Spare white gloves
White shoe polish
